Conditions:

EU Citizenship:

A registration fee of € 200 is to be paid when submitting your application. This amount will be subsequently deducted from the tuition fees. If you withdraw from the course before 15th August, this deposit will be refunded.

The tuition fees should be paid monthly (September to June) using a SEPA direct debit mandate:

German Program 10 payments of € 289,30 = in total € 2.893,00 / English Program 10 payment of € 299,40 = in total € 2.994,00

Other Citizens:

In order to fulfil the visa requirements non-EU citizens are required to pay 50% of the tuition fees on registration:

Cancellation:

If the registration is cancelled before the start of the study year all payments with the exception of € 200 administration fee will be reimbursed. If the student does not appear in class at the beginning of the study year and/or the cancellation is made **within the first four weeks** of the study year one **monthly instalment** will be reimbursed.

Withdrawal throughout study year:

If student withdraws due to personal reasons or due to academic performance throughout the study year the tuition fees for the complete study are to be paid.

Costs included:

The tuition fees cover: costs for copies of learning materials as well as the materials for the practical subjects, the transport costs for day excursions and the costs for the practical examination required before the diploma examination. Free WIFI in the whole school area, use of the career centre to find internship places and to organize foreign trips, as well as tutoring.

***Additional costs of € 102,00 are to be paid for the material used in the practical training subjects such as culinary arts. Please note that this is a flat fee and cannot be reimbursed due to the absence of the student during training hours.**

Other Conditions:

All students must be healthy in order to follow a career in hospitality and tourism. Special dietary requirements cannot be accommodated during the practical trainings.

If students are not insured with their parents and/or do not have an Austrian health insurance, an Austrian insurance is required. Costs for this insurance are not included in the tuition fees.
